The homeless outreach coordinator reports directly to the program manager. H/she is primarily responsible for outreach to the homeless in the geographic region of an outpatient drug and alcohol treatment and recovery program for English- and Spanish-speaking women and adolescents, including pregnant and parenting women and adolescents and their children. Duties include:
